A tally chart is a way of collecting data using vertical lines.

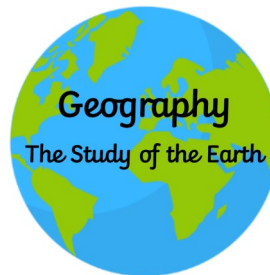
Our local village is called South Normanton and our nearest city is Derby.
