Derby is a city in England.

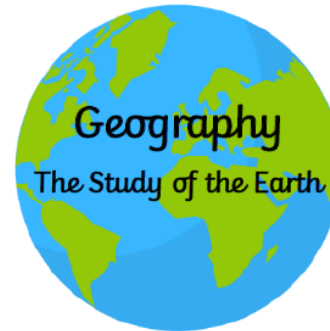
