We compare by finding the similarities and differences between two things.

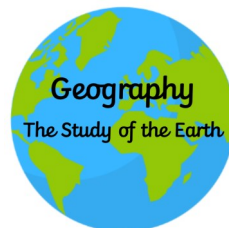
The purpose of the Likert scale is to make a judgement about the quality of an environment.




A conclusion is the end or finish of a process.
