Memories are not always reliable in telling us about the past.

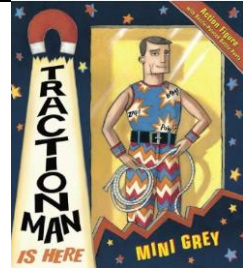
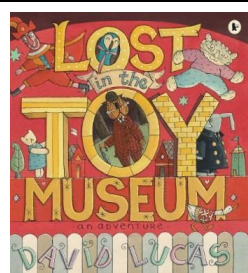
Design and Technology Sticky Knowledge
