Sugarloaf Mountain and the Amazon Rainforest and River are all physical features of Brazil

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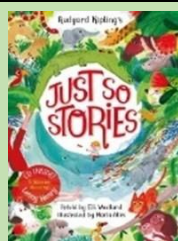
Design and Technology Sticky Knowledge

Tint		A shade or variety of colour.
Tone		The lightness or darkness of a colour.
Climate		The particular weather in a certain area.
